Plan your event

- o Use the conversation cards to break the ice and get everyone talking.
- o Share the topic you've chosen with the group and explain why it's important to you.
- o Give everyone a chance to talk about what's on their mind. If new topics come up, that's okay too.
- o Remember this conversation can be as structured or as free as you want. It's all up to you.
